



得獎設計師赴大溪地 考察交流 啟迪心靈

2017 年 3 月 25 至 4 月 1 日，兩位 JMA 國際珠寶設計比賽 2016 得獎設計師獲邀參加由香港大溪地黑珍珠協會主辦的「大溪地考察團 2017」，連同其他珠寶設計比賽得主親訪大溪地，期間進行一連串的文化及考察活動，了解大溪地珍珠的最新發展，加深對大溪地及大溪地珍珠的認識。

From 25 March to 1 April, 2017, the winners of JMA International Jewelry Design Competition 2016 were invited to participate in the "Tahiti Study Tour 2017", sponsored by the Hong Kong Tahitian Pearl Association (TPAHK) so as to enhance better understanding on the cultivation and development of Tahitian Pearls. A series of cultural events and visits are on the agenda for the designers.

A leading source of cultured pearls, Tahiti rests in the South Pacific. It is the biggest island and the economic, cultural and political center of French Polynesia. French Polynesia is often collectively named as Tahiti.
